






Lanier 2015-2016 School Uniform Policy and Dress Code

<u>Clothing</u>	<u>Solid Colors</u>	<u>Pictures</u>
<p><u>Shirts</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shirts can be ANY solid color. • Can be long sleeve or short sleeve • Can be a polo shirt, button down oxford shirt, or a blouse • <u>All shirts must have collars</u> • No t-shirts, or sleeveless shirts • No writing, logos, stripes, or patterns. 	<p><u>Any</u> solid color. This includes red, white, blue, teal, green, orange, purple, pink, and more!</p>	
<p><u>Pants</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can be pleated or flat front • <u>Uniform pants should have no outside stitching</u> • No cargo pants • <u>No skinny pants</u> • No jeans • Pants should fit on the waist and not sag. 	<p>Navy Tan/Khaki Black</p>	
<p><u>Jumpers</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Length must extend below the fingertips when the child is standing with hands to their sides 	<p>Navy Tan/Khaki Black</p>	
<p><u>Skirts & Shorts</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can be pleated or flat front. • No cargo shorts • Shorts should fit on the waist and not sag. • Shorts and skirts must extend below the fingertips when the child is standing with hands to their sides 	<p>Navy Tan/Khaki Black</p>	
<p><u>Shoes</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be closed-toe (no flip flops, crocs, or sandals) • Pre-K and Kindergarten prefer shoes without laces until students can tie their own shoes. 	<p>Any</p>	

Accessories - All jewelry, hair accessories, haircuts and colors should be modest and not distract from learning. If a teacher finds an accessory to be distracting, they will ask for the item to be removed and the student should not wear it again. No bandanas are allowed.

Spirit days are every Friday - Students may wear any color of denim pants, skirts, or shorts as long as they meet the length requirement. Jeans should not be skin tight. Students should wear a uniform shirt or a Lanier t-shirt.

Free Dress Day - On free dress days, students may wear any school appropriate clothes they choose. Make sure all shorts, skirts and shorts are appropriate lengths. No sleeveless shirts/dresses, jeggings, profanity, pajamas, or costumes.
